Capabilities in tackling novel situations and ill-defined problems	Students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • make rational decisions about ill-defined pharmaceutical problems in Chinese Medicine based on the best available evidence; and • identify potential approaches or research that will lead to improvement in pharmaceutical practice in Chinese Medicine.
3.	Capabilities in critical self-reflection, greater understanding of others, and upholding personal and professional ethics	Students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • demonstrate capabilities as pharmacists in Chinese Medicine and recognize one's own capabilities and limitations;

Capabilities in intercultural communication and global citizenship	Students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • describe the current status and problems of International trading of Chinese Medicine; and • identify socio-cultural factors that contribute to variation in the acceptance of, or conformity in clinical usage of medical prescriptions in Chinese Medicine.
