Credit Unit Statement

The Master of Finance (MFin) Programme offers mainly the survey courses which are 6 credits each. The majority of the courses are assessed by a combination of coursework (40-60%) and examination (40-60%).

Survey Courses

These courses focus on content and are taught predominantly by lectures (36 hours) supplemented by class discussion. The contact hours, student learning activities, and output requirements for each course will vary by instructor and learning models employed.

Learning activities include the following: lectures, individual consultations, case studies, class discussion, individual assignments and group projects. Learning hours (including both contact hours and all other forms of student learning activities) range from 120 to 150 hours.

Methods of assessment differ between courses but consist of class participation, individual assignments, group projects, individual and group presentations, quizzes, and examinations, depending on the nature of the course. Course instructors select the appropriate mix of delivery and assessments for students to achieve the learning outcomes. The number of words for written output is normally no more than 5,000 words.
